THE VILLAGE OF GRAND MANAN

BY-LAW 29-01

A BY-LAW RESPECTING THE STOPPING UP AND CLOSING OF A HIGHWAY IN THE VILLAGE OF GRAND MANAN

WHEREAS it is the determination of the Council of the Village of Grand Manan that the portion of the old highway located near Deep Cove is not required by the public for use;

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED as a By-Law of the Village of Grand Manan that that portion of highway known as locally as the Old Road or the Old Highway at Deep Cove and described as follows:

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain lot, piece or parcel of land premises situate, lying and being in the Village of Grand Manan, in the Parish of Grand Manan, in the County of Charlotte and Province of New Brunswick and more particularly bounded and described as follows to wit:

BEING that portion of land described as the "Old Highway Right of Way at Deep Cove" as shown on the Plan of Survey, Showing Old Highway Right Of Way AT Deep Cove, Village of Grand Manan, Parish of Grand Manan, Charlotte County, New Brunswick, prepared by Hughes Surveys & Consultants Ltd. and dated December 17th, 1999.

is hereby permanently stopped up and closed and all rights of the public to traverse same are discontinued.

This By-law shall not take effect until such time as the Village of Grand Manan has received properly executed copies of the Beach Access Easement Agreement and the Cemetery Access Easement Agreement.
